6/09/10 – PLA Mandate Language Spreads to Legislation

Today CIRT joined with other industry groups, lead by the Associated Builders & Contractors (ABC), in voicing their concerns regarding PLA language in the Kerry-Lieberman American Power Act that is being “floated” in the U.S. Senate. The letter was sent only to the Senate because the proposed legislation is still being formulated (in fact it does not yet have a bill number), but drafts indicate the bill has a provision entitled the Clean Energy Construction Careers Demonstration Project program (this initiative, contained in Section 4103, is the vehicle housing the PLA language).
