SUMMARY

The 2019 CIRT National Design & Construction Competition invited ACE Mentor Affiliate teams (student and mentors) from across the country to design solutions for one of three challenges: a playground or playscape, alleviate urban transportation congestion, and a community health clinic.

The competition is maintained, coordinated and juried by the Construction Industry Round Table (CIRT), in coordination with ACE Mentor National and the Chicago Architecture Center. The 2019 theme celebrates the innovations and contributions the design and construction community make to the quality of American life, while understanding the issues and challenges the industry faces to deliver on this legacy. The competition opened in September 2018 and entries were due in mid-March 2019. The competition served 607 students and 385 mentors from across the country.
