Transportation - **Colorado Springs Airport**: Serviced by major airlines; 15-minute drive; Non-stop flights; Shuttle service is available through Gray Line for \$24 per person one way; \$48 per person roundtrip. Denver International Airport: Serviced by all major airlines; 75-minute drive; Shuttle service is available through Gray Line for \$95 per person one way; \$190 per person roundtrip. Advance reservations are required and can be made by calling (719) 362-3276. Average cab fare is \$240+.
